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Connections Outside of Daniel 7

Fourth kingdom in Revelation: Character: 11:18 destroy the earth; 13:5, 6 mouth speaking great things, against God; 12:13 "persecuted the woman"; 13:7 "to make war with the saints, and to overcome them"; "Till": 12:6 "a thousand two hundred and threescore days"; 12:14 "a time, and times, and half a time"; 13:5 "forty and two months"; Judgment: 19:20 beast and false prophet "into a lake of fire"; 20:10 devil "into the lake of fire".
 Son of man is involved in the battle of kingdoms and judgment: Dan. 8:11; Matt. 25:31; Luke 22:29; John 5:27
 Saints receive kingdom: Matt. 25:34; Rev. 3:21; 20:4.
Judgment always involves an **investigation** based on history: Gen. 3:11, 13; Gen. 18:21; Eccl. 12:14; Dan. 5:18-24; Acts 7:51-53; Rev. 3:15.
All phases of judgment are in Dan. 5: investigation (18-24), verdict and sentencing (25-28), execution (30).
 First two phases in Matt. 23: investigation and verdict (29-37), sentencing (38 and 24:2).
 The **three angels' messages** address these three phases: First angel: final preaching of gospel, announcing opening of investigation, taking history back to creation (Rev. 14:6, 7). Second angel: verdict of fallen (14:8). Third angel: contrasting histories and sentences (14:9-12). Followed by execution: two harvests (14:14-20 One "like unto the Son of Man" takes the good; angel takes evil for wrath; see Matt. 13:39). Also Rev. 18 judgment on Babylon.
 Judgment as an **opening of hidden things**, of facing God: see Isa. 25:9 & Rev. 22:4 contrasted with Rev. 6:16.
 1Tim. 5:24, 25 "Some men's sins are open beforehand, going before to judgment; and some men they follow after. Likewise also the good works of some are manifest beforehand; and they that are otherwise cannot be hid."
 "Some men's sins are open beforehand, confessed in penitence, and forsaken, and they go beforehand to judgment. Pardon is written over against the names of these men. But other men's sins follow after, and are not put away by repentance and confession, and these sins will stand registered against them in the books of heaven." (MS 1a, 1890; in 7BC916) (Process of examination; see also GC425; Ev 224; cf. 2 Cor. 13:5; till last case decided GC613)
